## INSTRUCTIONS REVISED ROAD OPENING PERMIT

THE 2 PAGE PERMIT WILL BE PICKED UP BY THE LANDOWNER OR CONTRACTER AT THE NORWAY TOWN OFFICE.

THEY WILL FILL OUT THE "UPPER HALF" OF THE PERMIT, UP TO AND INCLUDING THE "DIG SAFE PERMIT #". THEY WILL THEN RETURN THE PERMIT TO THE TOWN OFFICE, GIVE US THEIR CONTACT TELEPHONE #, AND WE WILL TELL THEM THAT THEY WILL BE CONTACTED WITH A DATE AND TIME TO MEET WITH HIGHWAY, SEWER, AND WATER AT THEIR SITE.

AFTER THE REVIEW HAS BEEN MADE, THEY WILL RETURN THE PERMIT TO THE TOWN OFFICE, ALONG WITH THE LANDOWNER PERMIT FEE OF \$350 AND THE CONTRACTOR FEE OF \$650. A COPY OF THE PERMIT WILL BE GIVEN TO THEM ALONG WITH THEIR RECIEPT FOR THE FEES.

UPON COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT, THEY WILL CONTACT THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT TO SETUP A TIME FOR A FINAL REVIEW.

AFTER ALL 3 DEPARTMENTS HAVE "SIGNED OFF" THE PROJECT, THE CONTRACTOR PERMIT FEE WILL BE REFUNDED.

4. Must have a copy of certificate of liability insurance at the on-site meeting

- 8. COMPACTION MUST BE AT 95% AND ALL PAVEMENT WILL BE
- 9. SAW CUT.
- 10. NO PERMITS ISSUED AFTER OCTOBER 15<sup>th THRU</sup> MAY 15<sup>th</sup> unless it is an emergency situation. If there is an emergency situation, between October 15th and May 15th, the hot top will be replaced by using cold patch thru the winter and until May 15<sup>th</sup> when the hot top plants open. The contractor shall be responsible for the site thru the winter, which would include the application of cold patch when necessary.
